

## **Terms of use of the site of [www.braziliansoccerschools.ca](http://www.braziliansoccerschools.ca)**

### **General information**

1. The operator of the [www.braziliansoccerschools.ca](http://www.braziliansoccerschools.ca) website is:

2. The Website performs the functions of obtaining information about users and their behavior in the following way:

- a. By information entered voluntarily in forms.
- b. By saving cookies in the terminal devices (so-called "cookies").
- c. By collecting web server logs by the hosting operator Home.pl S.A., operating at the address [www.home.pl](http://www.home.pl)

3. The Website Operator allows licensed users who have a password and access code to enter and edit information provided on the website.

4. The Website Operator is not responsible for the content entered on the Website by licensed Users if, immediately after receiving notification of a given event infringing the rights of third parties or inconsistent with the Regulations, it will suspend publication of the content in question.

### **Information in forms**

1. The website collects information provided voluntarily by the user.

2. The Website may also save information about connection parameters (time stamp, IP address)

3. The data in the form is not shared with third parties otherwise than with the user's consent.

4. The data provided in the form is personal data - details regarding the handling of personal data can be found in our Privacy Policy.

5. The data provided in the form is processed for the purpose resulting from the function of a specific form, eg in order to process the service request or business contact.

6. The data provided in the forms may be provided to entities technically performing certain services - in particular it concerns the transfer of information about the registered domain holder to entities that operate internet domains (primarily Academic Computer Network jbr - NASK), payment service websites or other entities with whom the Service Operator cooperates in this respect.

### **Information about cookies**

1. The website uses cookies.

2. Cookies (so-called "cookies") are IT data, in particular text files, which are stored in the Website User's end device and are intended for using the Website's websites. Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which they originate, their storage time on the end device and a unique number.

3. An entity placing cookie files on the Website User's end device and accessing them is the Website operator.



4. Cookies are used for the following purposes:
  - a. create statistics that help to understand how Service Users benefit from websites, which allows improving their structure and content;
  - b. maintaining the Website User's session (after logging in), thanks to which the User does not have to on each subpage of the Website, re-enter the login and password;
  - c. determining the user's profile to display matched materials in advertising networks, in particular the Facebook Privacy Policy.
5. The Website uses two basic types of cookies: "session" cookies and "permanent" (persistent cookies). Session cookies are temporary files that are stored they are in the end device of the User until logging out, leaving the website or disabling the software (web browser). "Persistent" cookies are stored in the User's terminal device for the time specified in the cookie file parameters or until the User deletes them.
6. Software for browsing websites (web browser) usually by default allows storing cookies on the User's end device. Website Users can change the settings in this area. The web browser allows you to delete cookies. It is also possible to automatically block cookies. Detailed information on this subject is provided in the help or documentation of the web browser.
7. Restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionalities available on the Website.
8. Cookies placed on the Website User's end device may also be used by advertisers and partners cooperating with the Website operator.
9. We recommend reading the privacy policy of these companies to learn about the rules of using cookies used in the statistics: Google Analytics Privacy Policy, Facebook Privacy Policy.
10. Cookie files may be used by advertising networks, in particular the Google network, to display advertisements tailored to the manner in which the user uses the Website. For this purpose, they can save information about the user's navigation path or the time of staying on a given page.

### **Server logs**

1. Information about some of the behaviors of users are subject to logging in the server layer. This data is used only to administer the website and to ensure the most efficient service of hosting services.
2. The browsed resources are identified by URL addresses. In addition, the subscription may be subject to:
  - a. the time of arrival of the inquiry,
  - b. time to send a response,
  - c. name of the client station - identification performed by the HTTP protocol,
  - d. information about errors that occurred during the execution of the HTTP transaction,
  - e. URL address of the page previously visited by the user (referrer link) - in the case when the transition to the Website was made via a link,
  - f. information about the user's browser,
  - g. Information about the IP address.
3. The above data is not associated with specific persons browsing the website.
4. The above data is used only for server administration purposes.

### **Processing of personal data**

These Terms and Conditions are supplemented by the Privacy Policy applied by ICFDS Canada Limited as a personal data administrator, containing detailed rules for dealing with personal data and rights of Users whose data is processed. The applicable Privacy Policy can be found under the link.

### **Providing data**

1. The data is made available to third parties only within legally permitted limits.
2. Data enabling the identification of a natural person is made available only with the consent of that person.
3. The operator may be required to provide information collected by the Website to authorized authorities on the basis of lawful demands in the scope resulting from the request.

### **Statements of licensed users**

1. The licensed user agrees to the provisions of these Regulations and declares that:
  - he is entitled to exclusive and unrestricted copyrights to the published work;
  - may dispose of property rights to the published work;
  - the published work is not a work, adaptation or adaptation of someone else's work;
